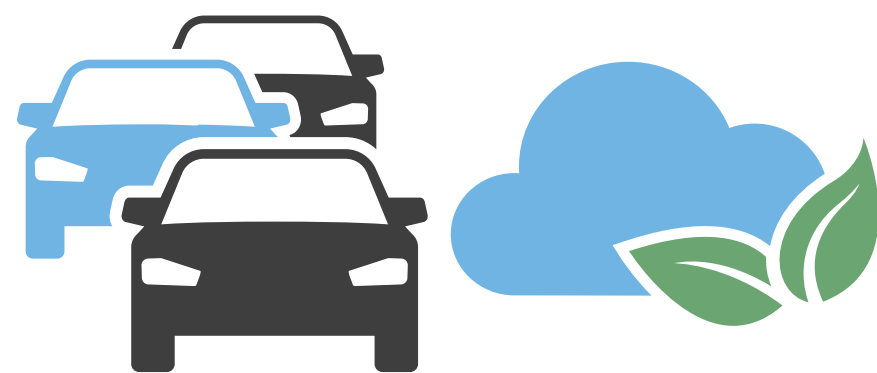
Corby is one of the fastest-growing towns in the country and it is vital that existing facilities are improved to meet the demands of this growth and the way people live and work.

By 2030, Corby will be a model for town centre regeneration in the Midlands. To do this the 1950s “Corby New Town” layout and infrastructure needs to be brought up to date for the 21st century.

A big factor in achieving this is to encourage active, healthier and more sustainable ways of travelling, which requires improving the environment.

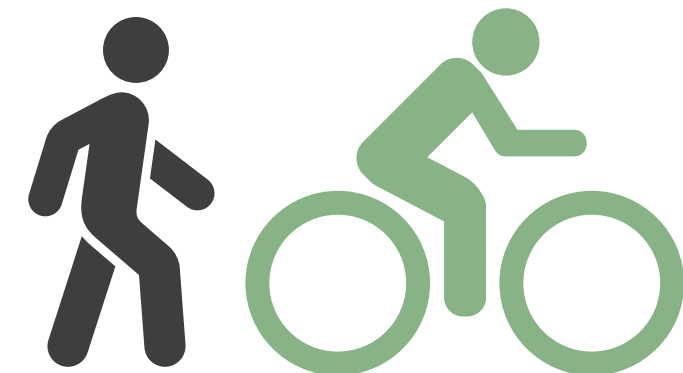
The Corby Station Link scheme is two Schemes in one.

Is the installation of traffic and air quality monitoring sensors around the town.

PART TWO



Improvements to the pedestrian and cycle facilities between the Railway Station and the Town Centre.

The Corby Station Link Scheme - Background

In 2020 Corby Borough Council, as part of the preparation and development of Corby's Town Investment Plan (TIP), asked for ideas from the community on improvements they would like to see in Corby.

These ideas were carefully considered and shortlisted. One idea on this list was the improvement of pedestrian and cycle facilities, to encourage people to walk and cycle more.

Safe and fit for purpose facilities needs to be provided to support this idea. In 2021, a feasibility study, to explore the options for improving pedestrian and cycle facilities between the Railway Station and the Town Centre was carried out.

A business case and concept design for the scheme were submitted to the Department of Levelling Up, Housing and Communities (DLUHC) at the end of June 2022.

A decision on the funding application is expected in the autumn of 2022.

While waiting for the results of the funding application, North Northamptonshire Council are taking the opportunity to inform the community of the scheme's progress.

The scheme's design is not finalised and further consultation will take place with stakeholders and the community if the funding application is successful.

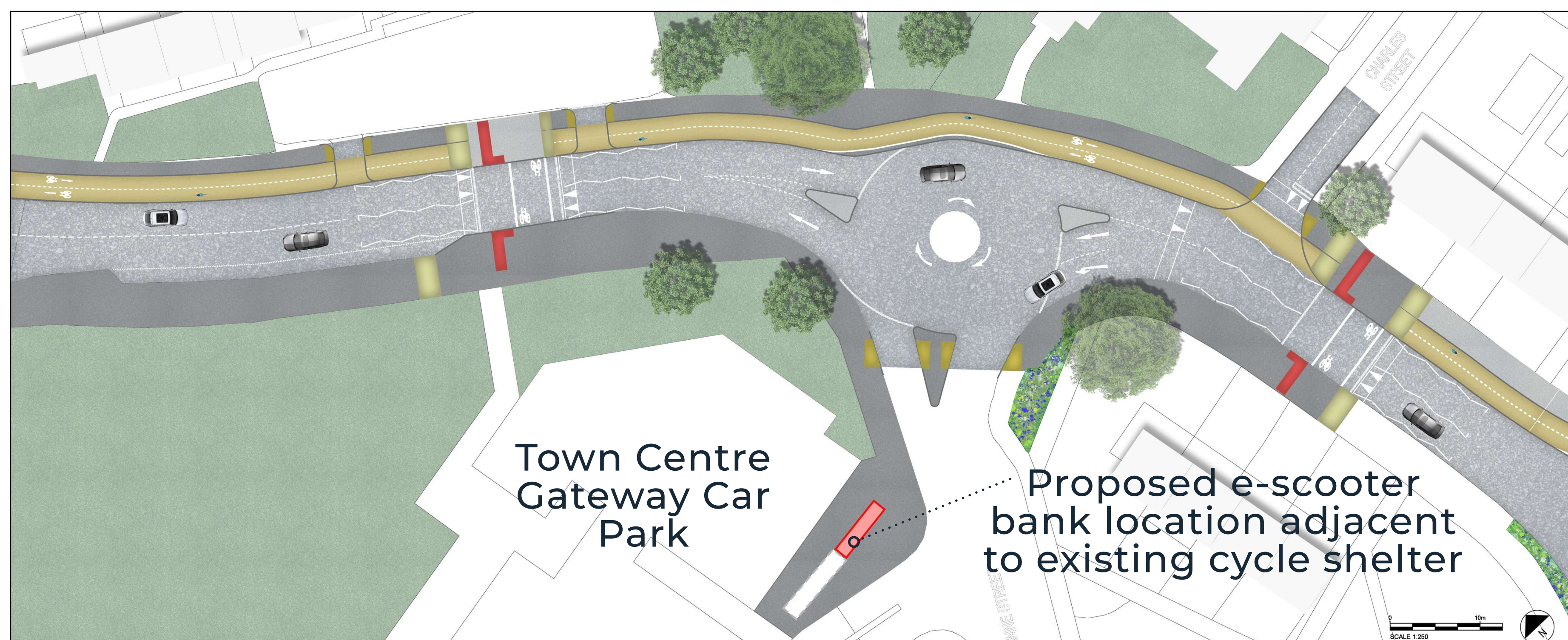
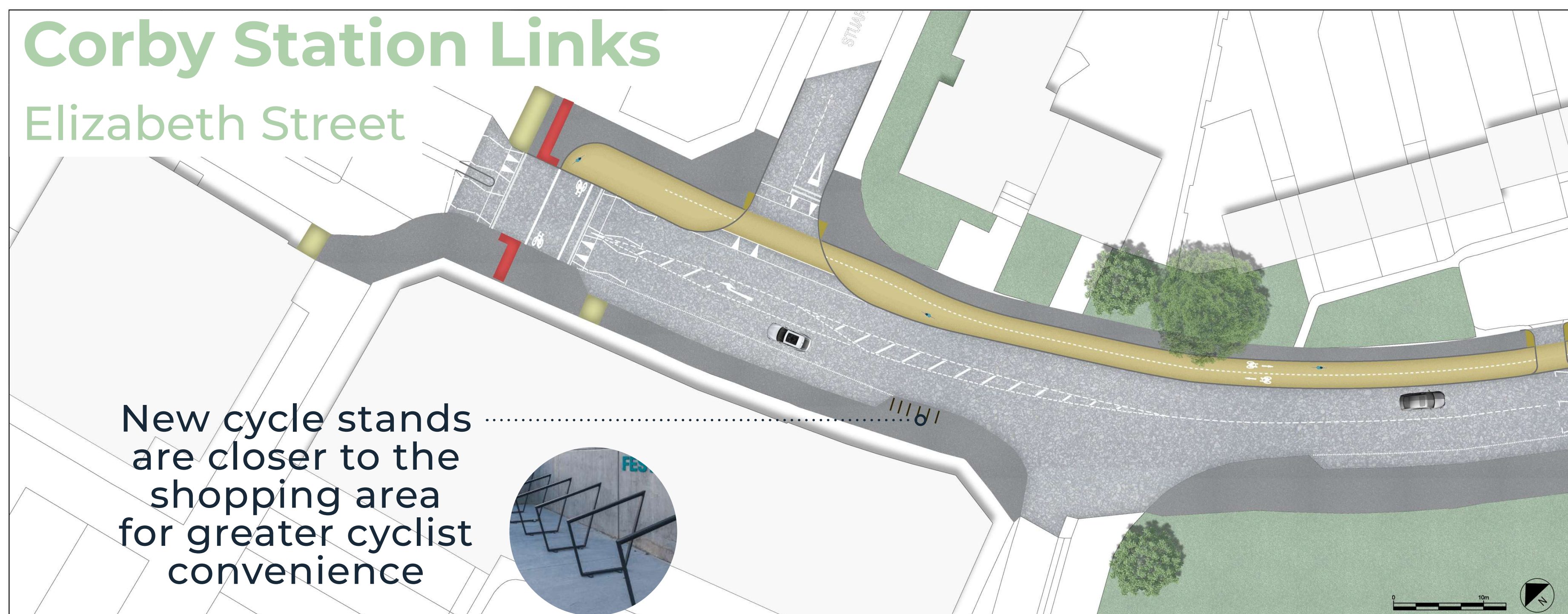

- ✓ Improve the public realm areas creating a better local environment.

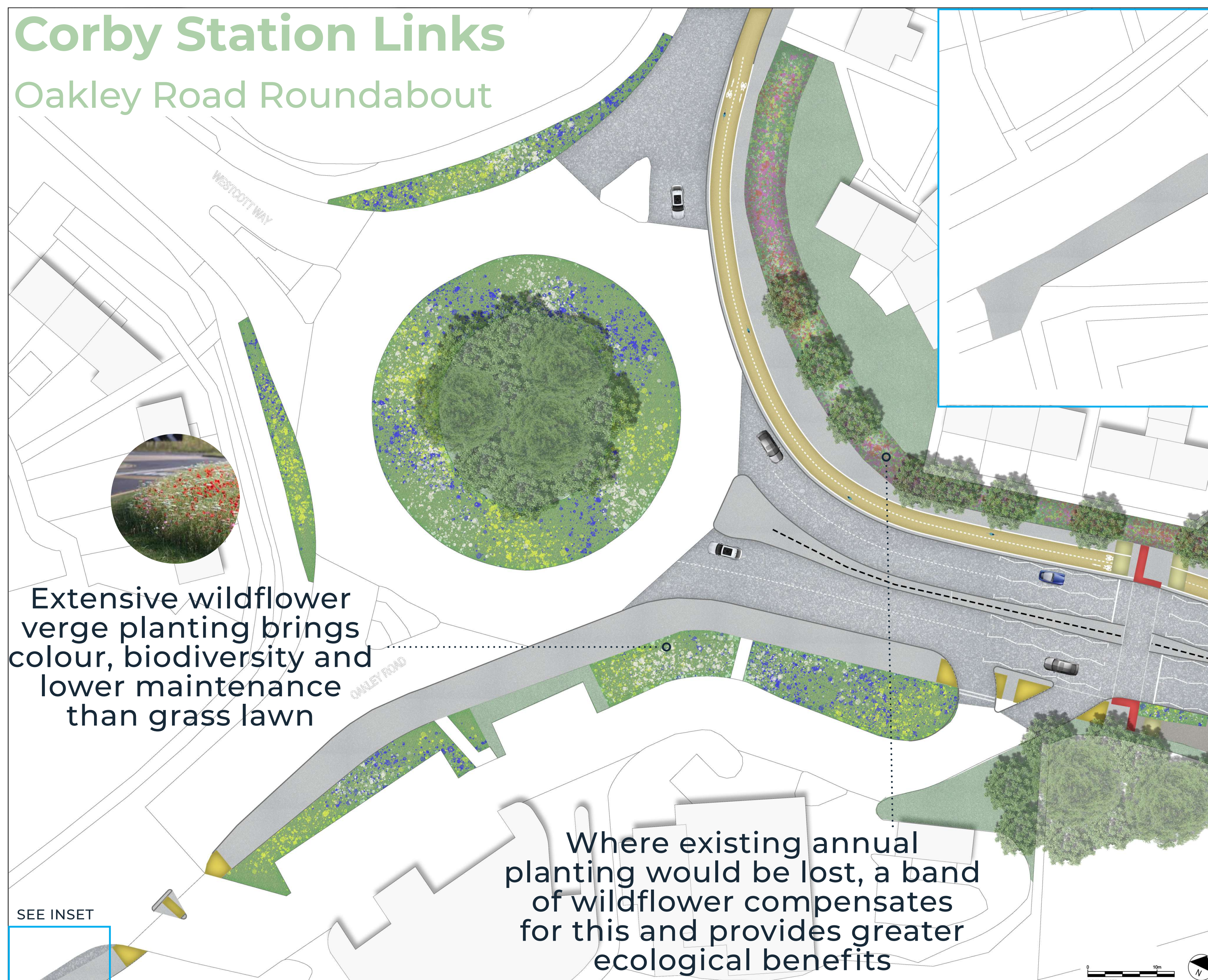

- ✓ Information on road user movements and air quality data to support future schemes.

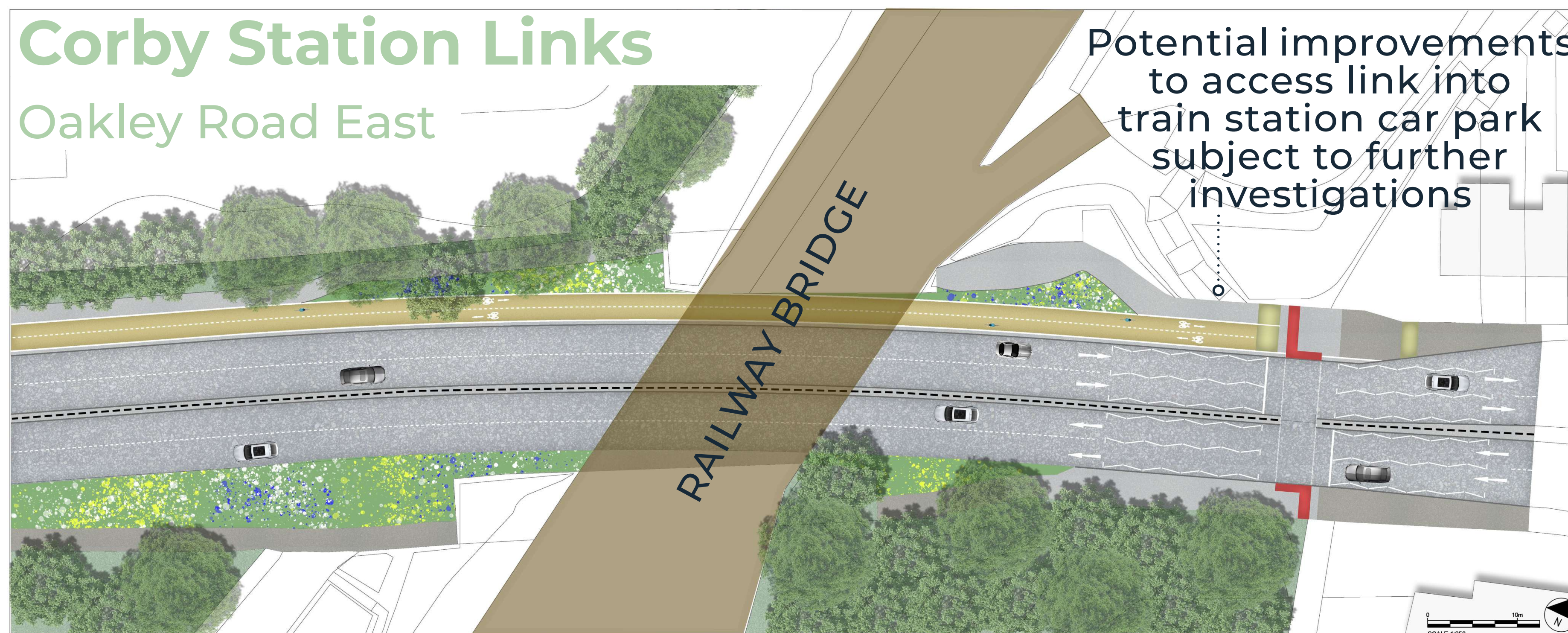

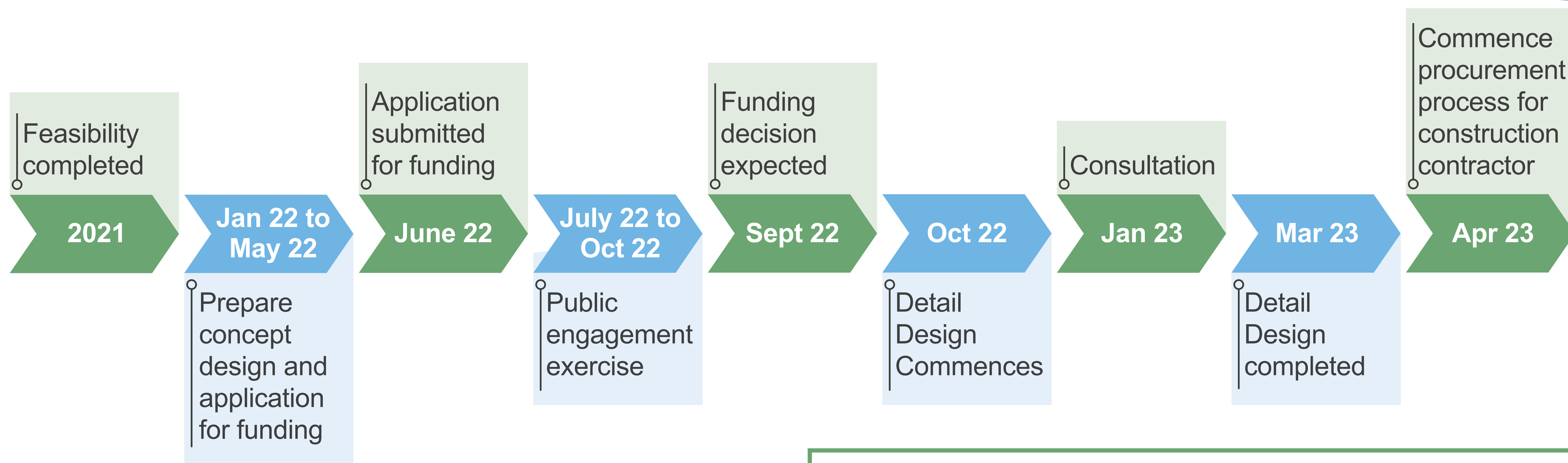
- ✓ Segregated facilities for pedestrians and cyclists that encourages those with less experience to change the way they travel.
