***UPDATED* Town Centre To Train Station Link Road, Elizabeth Street– Full Closure**

What's Happening?

Where: Elizabeth Street, Corby.

What: Road Closure – We will be carrying out work to remove the existing pedestrian island between Stuart Road & Corporation Street and improve drainage connections on Elizabeth Street. This needs to be undertaken under a full road closure.

When *UPDATED*: Monday 3 February 2025 – Friday 14 February 2025

Working Times: 08:00–17:00 (road closure lifted outside of these hours with a one-way system in place on the southbound carriageway.)

Traffic Management: Due to the width of the road, this work will be carried out under a full road closure. We will allow vehicular access in the daytime for deliveries and business/resident access. At nighttime, the closure will be removed, and access will be maintained on the current one-way system in place on the southbound carriageway.

Emergency vehicles: Access will be allowed when safe to do so in an emergency situation. Otherwise please follow diversion routes.

Residents/Businesses: Pedestrian access to all businesses and residents will be maintained. Deliveries on Elizabeth Street may be impacted, but access will be allowed when safe to do so.

Public Transport: Bus stops on Elizabeth Street will be temporarily suspended. Bus companies have been notified and schedules may vary.

The taxi rank on Elizabeth Street will be closed during this time.

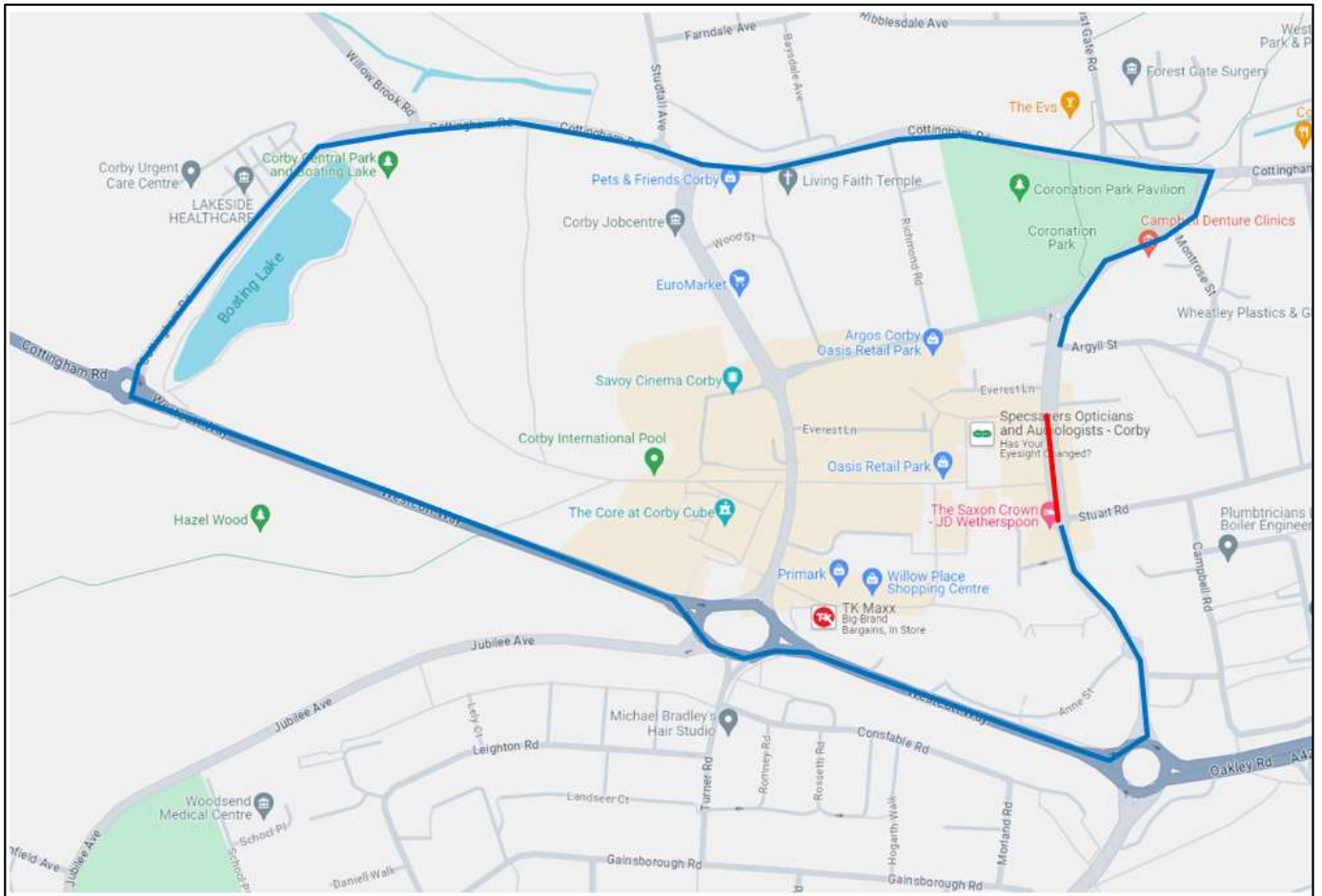
